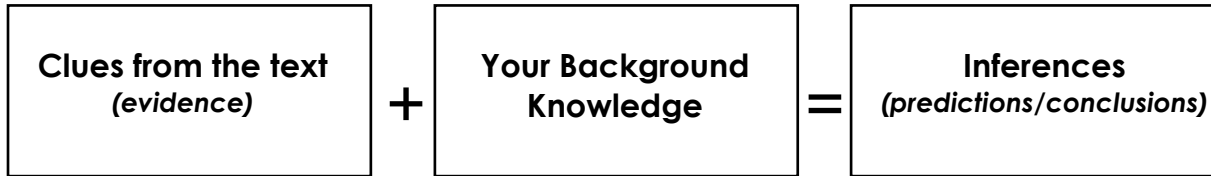


Reading Comprehension

Drawing Conclusions & Making Inferences

This is our new comprehension focus for the beginning of Term 3.



When you make an **inference**, you go **beyond** the author's **words** to understand what is **not said** in the text.

Your task is to make **at least 3 inferences** about each of the following photos in your workbook. Make sure you explain why you think this - use evidence from each photo.

Example



- *I infer that inside this man's backpack is a parachute, as he is skydiving and he will need it for a safe landing.*
- *Perhaps this man is a risk taker and enjoys extreme sports because he is sky diving.*
- *I can conclude that this is an adult as children would not be allowed to skydive and if so, they would be much smaller.*
- *I infer that this man has jumped out of a plane rather than off the mountain as I know skydivers jump out of planes. I have seen my dad do it before.*
- *I predict that this man is an experienced skydiver because he is diving alone, rather than with an instructor.*
